Over 31 years ago, The Rev. Forbes Thomson introduced the concept of “Fellowship with Food”. The idea evolved to become a short programme followed by a potluck supper on the third Saturday of the month. A group to incorporate both men and women of all ages was a novel idea for church groups at that time. Koinonia continues to be a venue for food, friendship and enlightenment for 20 - 40 folk with meetings from October (September has a congregational corn roast) to April.
