## PLEASE NOTE:

### Street Construction

The City will soon begin installation of sewers and watermain on Suffolk Street East (Church side) between Norfolk St and Woolwich St. Suffolk Street will be closed for approximately two weeks beginning March 22. Norfolk Street will be open to traffic and parking will still be available on Norfolk St. Suffolk Street will remain closed during the weekend of March 27/28; however Suffolk St. will be open to traffic April 2-4 (Easter weekend) even if construction has not been completed. Once the work has been completed on Suffolk St the contractor will be working on Norfolk St *north* of Suffolk St to Green St.
