**It’s IN you to Give!**

Between today and September 11th, the Guelph Blood Donor Clinic needs another 1,200 people to book appointments to donate. If you are eligible to donate please consider assisting the Clinic in meeting the needs of patients in local hospitals. The situation is the same across the country.

Canadian Blood Services expects that over the coming weeks more blood will be shipped to hospitals than current donor appointments will provide. This, in turn, will put a strain on reserves. Between now and September 11 Canadian Blood Services needs to collect 137,200 units of blood to meet hospital demand nationally. However, Canadian Blood Services is already 10,000 donation appointments short of where we should be and that gap could increase as the summer progresses.

Anyone able to donate is encouraged to call 1 888 2 DONATE to book an appointment. Walk-ins are also welcome. Thank you for your support. St. Andrew’s is a Partner for Life with the Guelph Blood Donor Clinic.
