Relief for Haiti

PWS&D is responding to the victims of Haiti's earthquake through the Action by Churches Together Alliance. As one of the largest alliances working on relief in Haiti, the ACT Alliance continues to provide:

- Water purification equipment
- Portable hospitals
- Medical equipment
- Medical teams of doctors and nurses
- Blankets
- Jerrycans
- Healthcare for children
- Trauma counseling
- Tents and temporary shelter
- Hygiene kits

An estimated two million people are homeless and 200,000 are assumed dead. Several strong aftershocks have caused more damage and deaths, and sent people fleeing the city for rural areas.
