is now available from members of the Women's Missionary Society. As long as supplies last, these calendars will be on sale in the church hall after the Worship Service.

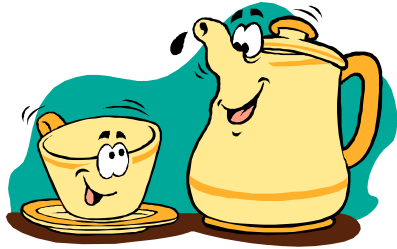
